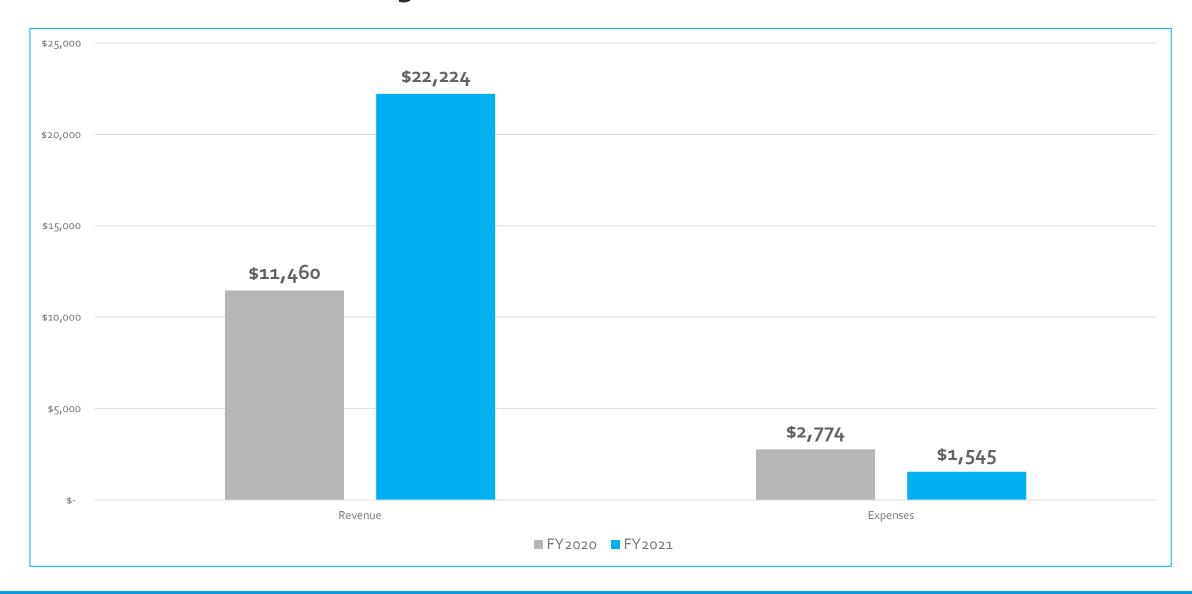

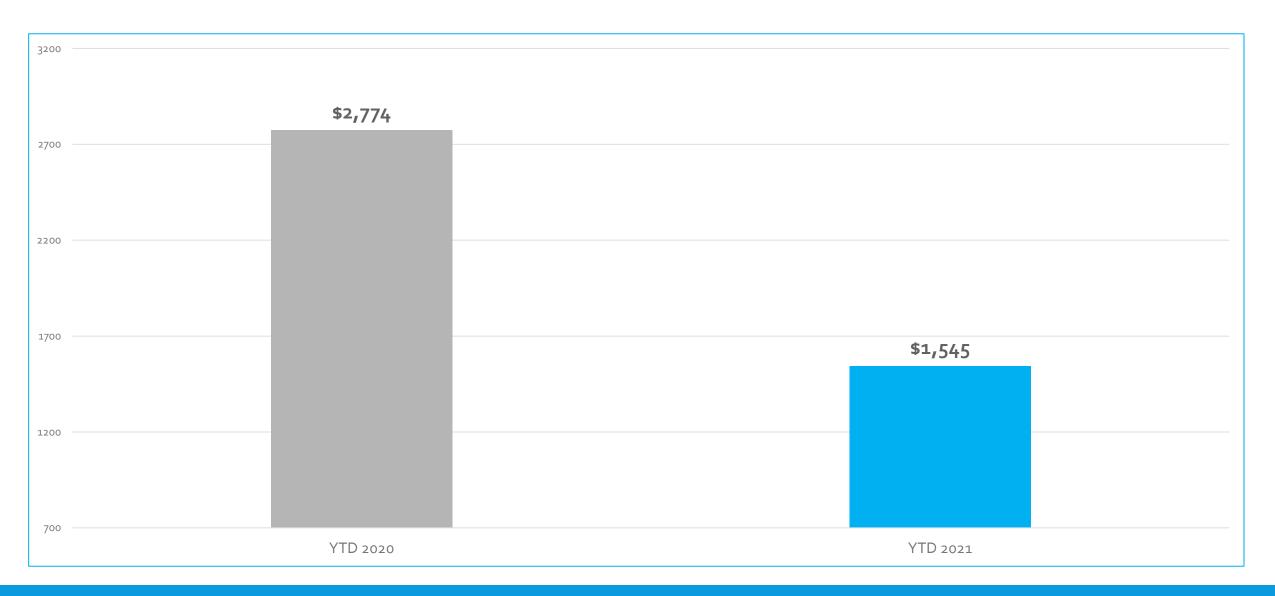

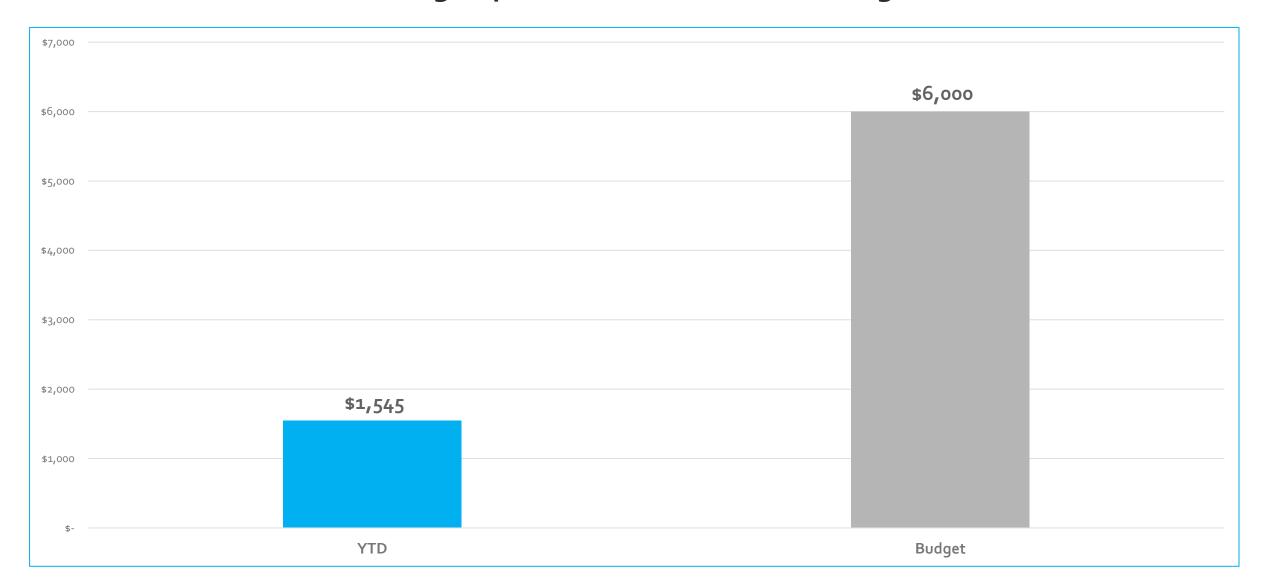
Fundraising Revenue October: YTD2021 vs. YTD2020



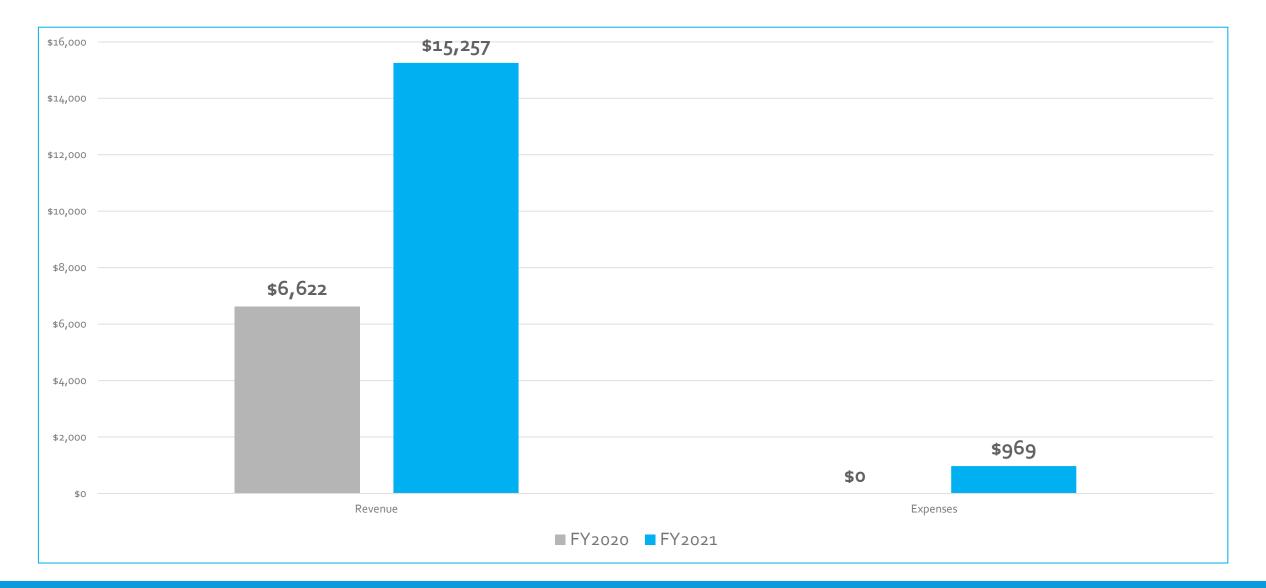
Fundraising Expenses October: YTD2021 vs YTD 2020



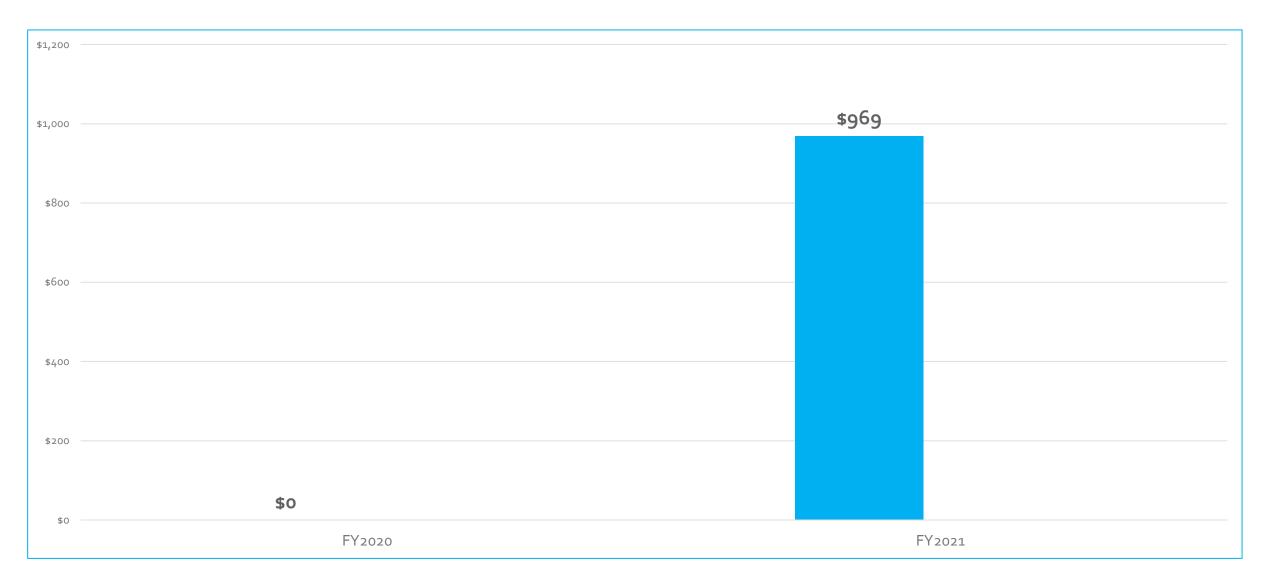
Fundraising Expenses October YTD vs. Budget



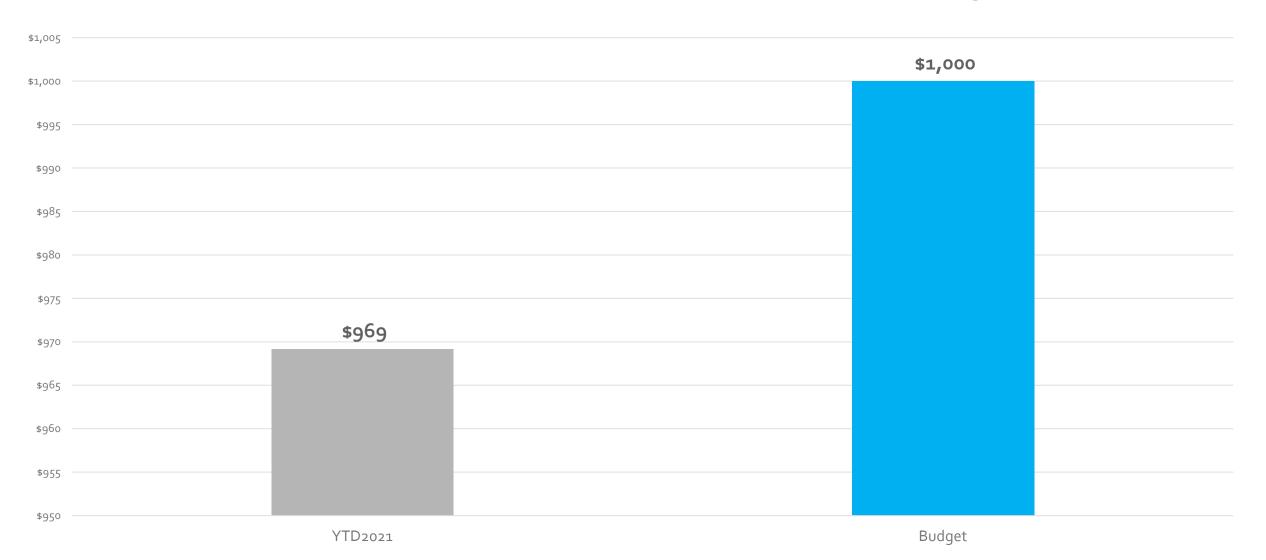
Membership/Development Revenue October: YTD 2021 vs YTD2020



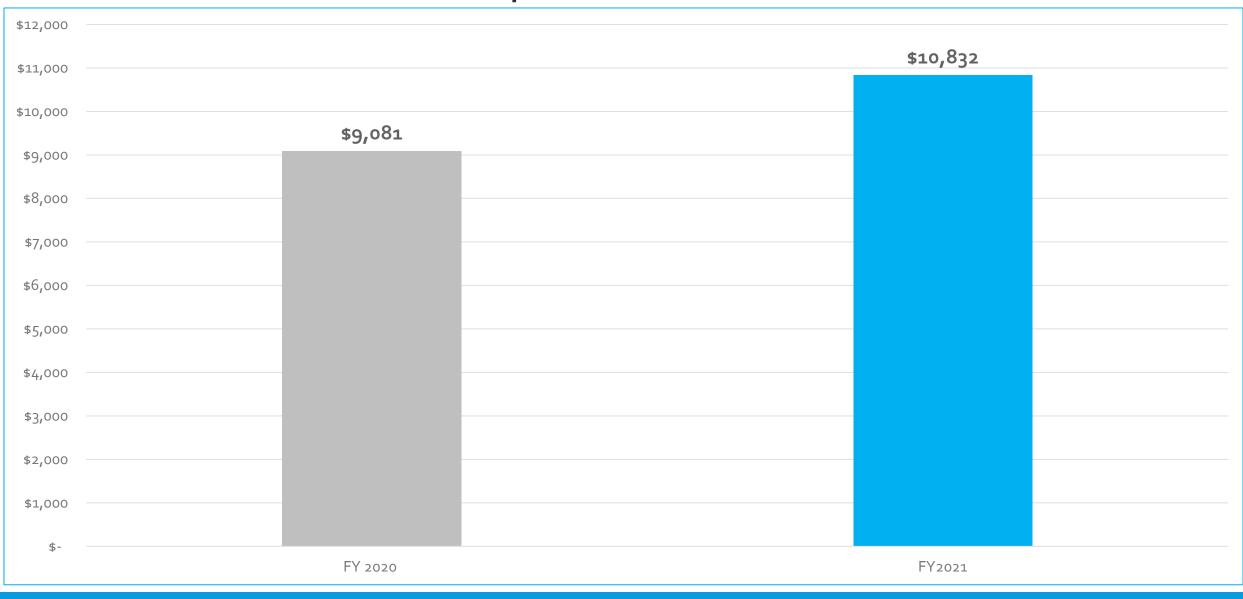
Membership/Development Expenses October: YTD 2021 vs YTD 2020



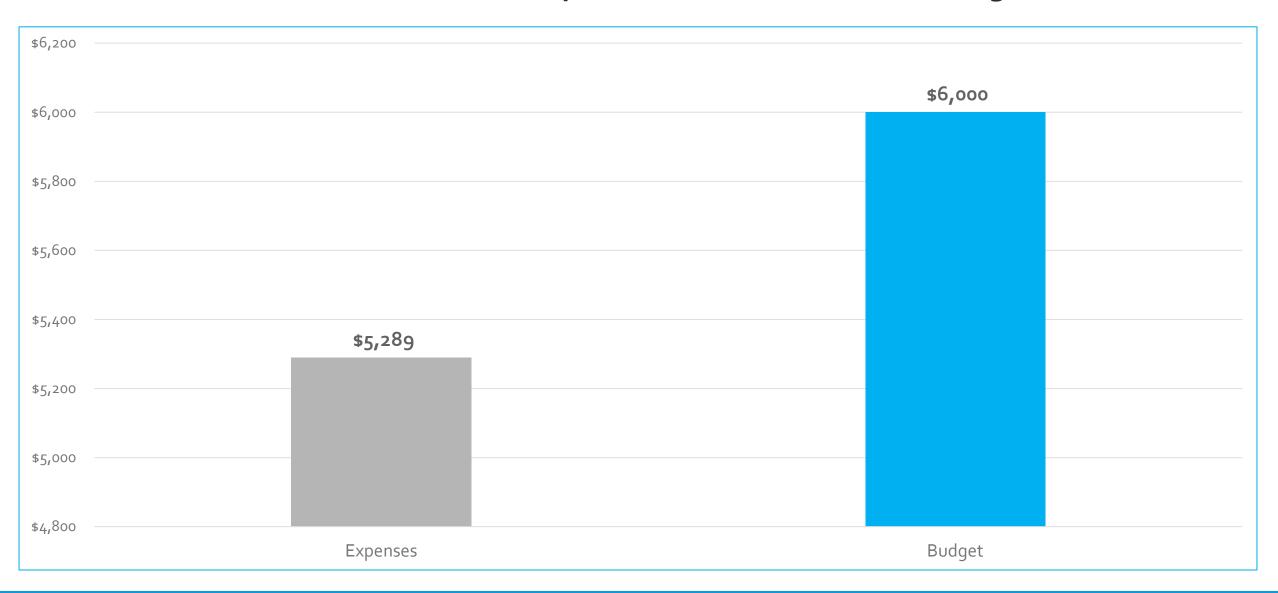
Membership/Development October YTD vs. Budget



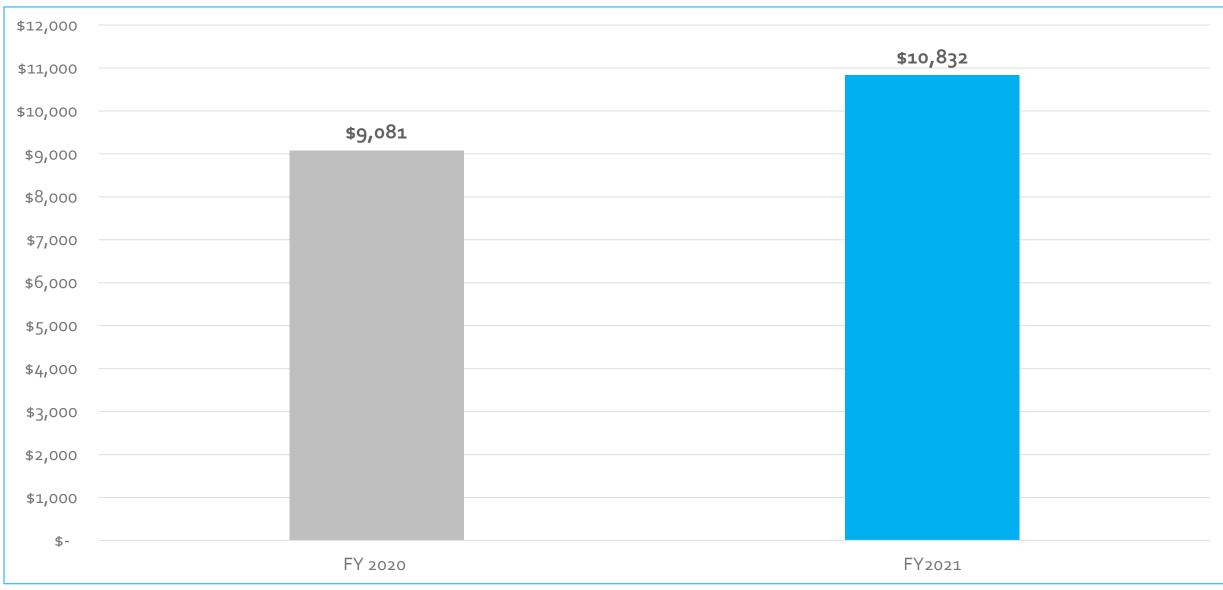
Curious Fox Expenses October: YTD2021 vs YTD2020



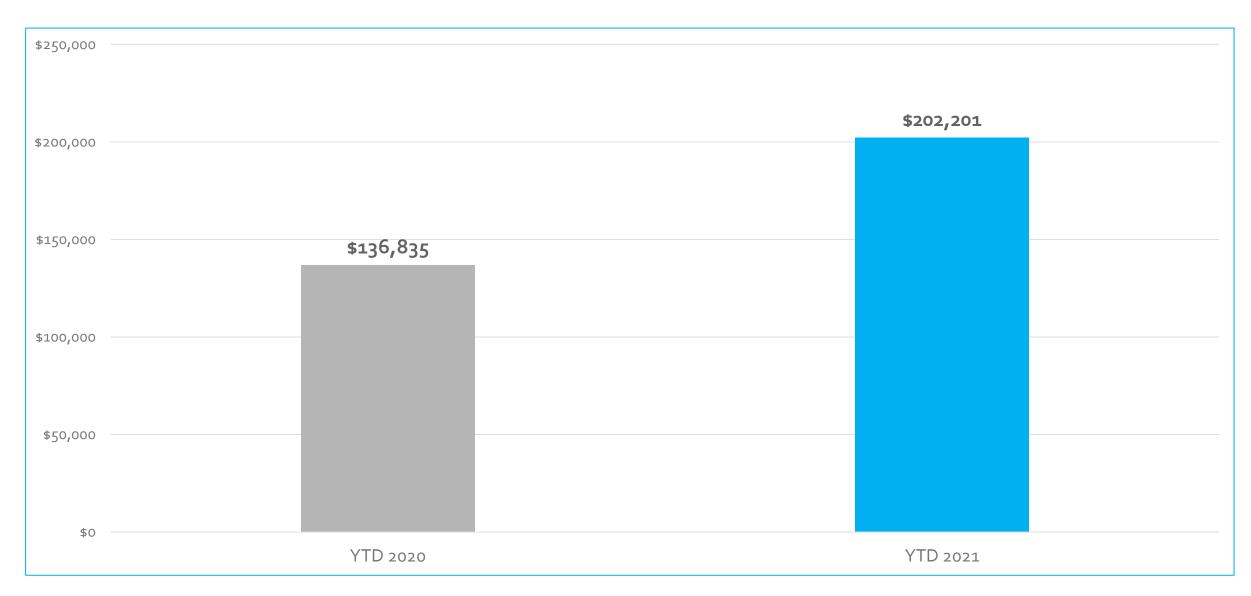
Curious Fox Expenses October FY2021 vs. Budget



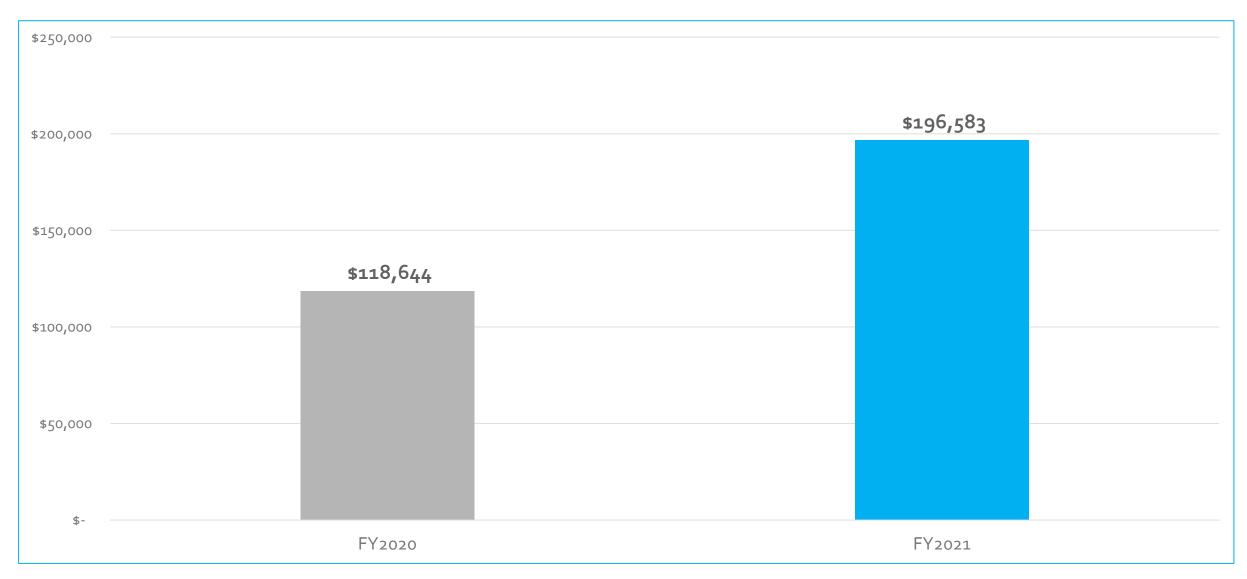
Curious Fox Net Total Sales October YTD2021 vs YTD2020

 - iv. Steel Beam Theater Actors at Museum portraying George Bailey and Mary
 - v. Rising Lights Project- has teamed up with us for an inclusive, accessible night of FUN! They will be selling their honey and offering a tasting. The entire front patio and sidewalk near bike rack will be reserved for wheelchair and adults with special needs so that they can see the parade.
 - vi. Hot cider/cocoa and cookies
- c. If anyone is interested in helping anytime between 12-5:30, please let me know! It's going to be a fun day!

II. Exhibits 2022

- a. As we had discussed at our last meeting, we are moving forward with the Collection processing exhibit for the spring exhibit. I am looking into getting plexiglass that hooks onto tables to help protect the artifacts. I will also be putting together signage that interprets the process. Sam S. has come up with a great educational program called "Adopt an Artifact" (see attached), which will pair nicely with this exhibit. It might also generate a bit of revenue. I am excited to continue working through the collection and getting it to what it needs to be.
- b. For our Fall exhibit, the Education committee and I have decided to focus on Wiliam Luckett- local muralist/artist and descendant from Joanna Gardner, first African-American to settle in St. Charles. The granddaughter of William Luckett recently reached out to the museum in the hopes of sharing some more information about her family. The Education Committee has also been actively seeking out more information on Luckett's mural at the Methodist Church on the west side of town, which is now a dance studio. Our goal is to not only share Luckett's story and talent with the community, but to also add to his discourse. We are developing oral history questions to ask his granddaughter.



III. Community Partnerships

- a. Preservation Partners of the Fox Valley
 - i. I met with PPFV two weeks ago about prospective partnerships for 2022. In the summer we are partnering up and doing a Pickle Weekend program. Our goal is to tie our organizations together, while also bringing in some local restaurants. Our goal is to have a pickling demo, a possible takehome jar of pickles, and a pickle tasting from restaurants. We still need to nail down all the details, but we are looking forward to partnering on this. It will be sometime in the summer, most likely July.
 - **ii.** PPFV is also partnering with us for *Grave Reminders* this next year. They are going to provide volunteers to play the 5 Durant children, as well as costuming.
- b. Steel Beam Theatre
 - i. The Steel Beam Theatre is not only helping us for the Holiday Hotspot, but also for Grave Reminders next year. They have agreed to loan us actors and costuming. We have also started the conversation of possibly doing a play in 2023 about the history of St. Charles based off the Alice Davis play. This is still in conversation and not nailed down, but still exciting.
